



Complimentary coach from Highcliff Marriott to BIC (running back and forth at peak times)

There is a complimentary coach running from the Highcliff Marriott to the BIC - back and forth between the two properties during peak times at the conference (which includes space for one wheelchair). Auditorium facilities

- An induction loop system, which can be linked to hearing aids.
- Sign language interpretation during all auditorium sessions; a number of seats are reserved for attendees using this service, at the front of the auditorium.
- Reserved seats at the front of the auditorium for those who would benefit from being closer to the stage due to a visual impairment.

Security and safety

Access to the BIC is possible only with a valid conference pass worn with the official lanyard. Conference photo passes must be worn visibly at all times within the secure zone. Anyone found in the secure area without a valid pass will be escorted from the venue.

All attendees will be subject to compulsory bag searches and metal detector wanding at the entrance. To ensure you can access the venue as quickly as possible please only bring essential items with you into the conference venue. Please allow time for queuing during key times – particularly after lunch and ahead of popular events. No sharp objects will be allowed in the BIC (including knitting needles).

Under no circumstances will any large bags or suitcases be allowed into the secure zone. Any bag left unattended will be brought to the attention of the police and may be removed and/or destroyed.










The BIC Ground Floor






Conference venue plans
