I want the Party to be alive to what I think are the opportunities and threats for the party with regard to local government across Great Britain.

Then there's strategic authority mayors. We cannot afford to make the same mistake with them as we did with Police & Crime Commissioners. We must take these fights seriously - because our opponents will.
