He coordinated the campaigns that delivered four gains in Oxfordshire in the General Election and gain control of the County Council in May this year.


Neil is a widely respected party trainer and has worked as the party's Youth & Student Officer, for the Campaigns Department, ALDC and several MPs and MEPs.
