I have represented UK Disabled People at the United Nations in Geneva three times, presenting the UK Shadow Report, and have given oral evidence to the House of Lords Select Committee on the Disability and Equality Act.

Last year, I stood for parliamentary selection. Although I was not chosen, it strengthened my resolve to serve our party in a way that can transform how we campaign, communicate, and win.
