- Chair of the newly-formed St Neots and Mid Cambridgeshire Local Party. County councillor since 2021. Built local support and worked hard to help elect 3 new Lib Dem MPs in our area last year. Re-elected to the county in May 2025 with more than 50% of the vote and a six fold increase in majority.
- Chaired the county council campaign in 2025 which led to Liberal Democrats forming a majority on Cambridgeshire for the first time ever. Tories reduced from 28 seats to just 10. Currently Chair of Children's and Young People's Committee and group chair.
- Many years' experience of successful campaigning at local and national level, securing the victory of many councillors, MPs and MEPs.
