Federal Council doesn't work - here's how I would fix it



I was on the Federal Council until May this year, when I became Cllr rep on the Board. In that time, it only 'called in' two Board items:

- Use of Non Disclosure Agreements
- A huge increase in the expenses for the Presidential election

I organised both of these call ins

It doesn't work because:

- Many FC members don't turn up to meetings
- It makes no use of its broader powers to scrutinse the Board

How I would fix it:

- The FC Chair should have a frank discussion with anyone who misses 3 consecutive meetings (they can't make them quit)
- The FC should use its powers for broader Scrutiny. The Constitution says:

"The Council shall be responsible for scrutinising the work of the Federal Board, including ensuring that decisions are being taken in line with the party strategy as voted for by Conference, and may require a response on any issue from the Board."

For example the FC could review why the Party's attempt to engage with ethnic minority voters has been so unsuccessful & the Alderdice review not been effectively implemented
