

Keeping Conference Liberal

I am standing again for FCC after a 9-year gap, **appalled by the discrimination** I have seen against vulnerable people from protected minorities, and equally at the **bland agendas** while relevant and radical Conference submissions are **blocked** from debate.



On FCC I have worked to **help those on low incomes** to attend; supported the interests of **Party bodies** while putting fair eligibility criteria in place; I've also been a voice for **active campaigners**.

If we just debated what the Leadership want, we would have never had policy for equal marriage and trans rights. Nor would we hear from local government and Mayoral candidates. We should have better agendas than we did this year.

We should ensure the **interests of Party members** and groups are set fairly alongside the necessary goal of maximising income. Critically, we must be a **safe and inclusive space**, and not tolerate organisations

tolerate organisations that generate harassment at Conference as in recent times.

I'm a **successful campaigner** in Oxfordshire in a Labour-facing area; I chair the County Council group and am also South Central Regional Campaigns Chair. I know what it takes to win.

I've played a full part in Conference, on FCC and over 20 years as a **compere of Glee Club** - an event which has been made more difficult to stage in recent years. It is part of what makes our Conference Liberal.
