In the end, it all boils down to money - or, too often, a lack of it.

Public investment cancelled, public services cut, and the great British public consistently let down by policy impotence – with public purse pressures adversely affecting our ambitions too.

How can we fund our plans to turn things around? Education? Welfare? Green growth? Energy security? Our NHS? Defence?

Britain is a rich country, not least in talent terms – yet a broken fiscal system allows the wealth created by hard-working British families to be syphoned into the pockets of privilege. How so?

If only we could <u>collect and recycle</u> this wealth in ways that are:

- unavoidable especially to offshore tax dodgers;
- sustainable which windfall taxes are NOT; and

Britain may never match Norway's two trillion-dollar LVT-based Sovereign Wealth Fund* but let's make a start. LVT is powerful, principled and potentially highly popular – even in Tory targets if sold as a <u>tax switch</u>. Let's deal with the difficulties and articulate the advantages. If we care and strive for fair, then it's time to dare!
