1998 Joined the Lib Dems while a student at UCL.

2000 Served as Treasurer of Lib Dem Youth and Students

2001 Parliamentary Candidate for Dover. Won the best swing in Kent.

2003 Organised my first local election campaigning, helping two friends gain seats on the District Council.

2005 Parliamentary Candidate for Dover. Won the best swing in Kent.

2006 Elected to the Lib Dem Regional Executive which I served on for about 10 years including some time time as Vice Chair.

2009 MEP Candidate for South East England

2012 Won a hotly contested selection for the seat from which Sharon Bowles MEP was retiring.

2014 Chaired the European Election Campaign in the SE. Raised £250,000. Fighting the swing against the Coalition, I failed to retain the #2 seat, but we saved the seat of my running mate Catherine Bearder MEP.

2016 Spoke for Remain at over 30 village hall type debates in the EU Referendum.

Jan 2017 Elected in a Town Council By-election in Faversham as (then) the only Lib Dem.

May 2017 Elected to Kent County Council as first ever Lib Dem county councillor for Faversham.

2019 Elected to the European Parliament. Helped my local team take control of our Town Council.

2020 Unseated as an MEP by Brexit.

2021 Re-elected to Kent County Council and elected as Lib Dem Leader.

2023 Helped Lib Dems retain control of Faversham Town Council.

Became first Chair of the Lib Dems Federal Council (2023-25)

2025 Elected for a third term to Kent County Council and became Leader of the Opposition.
