# A vital scrutiny champion and voice for the regions

Dr Phil Bennion is one of the sharpest policy brains in the Lib Dems, who served 10 years on FPC before being elected to the European Parliament.

As a Midlands MEP, he shaped EU legislation on employment and safer lorries. He is now Vice President of Liberal International. the global federation of 90 liberal parties, and regularly represents LI at the UN Human Rights Council in Geneva.

As VP, Phil has this year restored direct meetings between the Lib Dems and Renew Europe MEPs

for the first time since Brexit. He is the only UK participant in the RENEWPAC project between Europe and African allies to boost investment, avert reliance on China and help reduce migration from Africa to Europe.
